## Greencorps Chicago Youth Program

## Youth Program Instructor

Greencorps Chicago is the Chicago Department of Transportation's community greening and job training program run in partnership with WRD Environmental. Greencorps Chicago empowers residents from Chicagoland's neighborhoods to create change in their communities and lives through training, service, and career opportunities in the environmental fields.

The Greencorps Chicago Youth Program (GCYP) is a summer youth employment program, administered by the Chicago Department of Transportation and managed by WRD Environmental. GCYP staff teams work out of various Chicago Public Schools and community-based locations. Significant portions of the program are taught outdoors at a variety of project sites throughout the City of Chicago, such as community gardens, Chicago Park Districts, and Forest Preserves. Site teams consist of a Youth Program Instructor, a Youth Program Mentor, and an Assistant Instructor. The Youth Program Instructor will spend the majority of their time teaching horticulture, ecological restoration, environmental sciences, and bicycle building/maintenance/safety. The GCYP staff team will work alongside CPS staff and external partners to ensure youth have a safe and transformative summer learning experience.

### Responsibilities of the Youth Program Instructor include:

- Lead activities and lessons that engage youth in how to build a bicycle from a box, horticulture, urban forestry, ecological restoration, resource conservation, green infrastructure, urban agriculture, nutrition, bicycle maintenance, and safety
- Support Mentors in executing Greencorps curriculum
- Mentor and coach Assistant Instructor in planning and executing selected Greencorps activities
- Maintain order and safety in indoor and outdoor learning and work environments
- Support and provide daily oversight of youth in completing learning activities
- Plan and safely lead group bicycle rides and field trips
- Prepare youth to complete hands-on field projects
- Develop and manage site projects (plan project schedule, order materials, etc.)
- Adhere to schedule and submit reports for tracking youth progress
- Exhibit appropriate interpersonal skills and professional behavior to support a positive workplace environment
- Ability to work from **June 12 - August 4, 2023**
- **COVID-19 vaccination required**
- **Must be at least 21 years of age**
- **1<sup>st</sup> Aid & CPR Certification, or willingness to certify before deadline**
- **Ability to complete the CPS volunteer process and pass a criminal background check**

### Qualifications for this position include:

- **Capable and willing to ride a bicycle in the City of Chicago**
- **Education, training, or experience equivalent to an AS degree in horticulture, environmental sciences or related fields**
- **Experience teaching in a classroom and/or outdoor setting**
- Comfortable with working outside planting, mulching, and watering
- Ability to fix and maintain bicycles or willingness to be trained
- Experience working with youth ages 16-19, highly preferred
- Social perceptiveness and empathy and experienced with Trauma-Informed Care approaches
- Culturally competent and able to relate and communicate with diverse populations and groups
- Excellent communication, organizational and interpersonal skills
- Computer skills (Microsoft Office, Google Drive, email communication, etc.)

### Position details:

- Seasonal position, Monday through Friday, 8am to 2:30pm, 32.5 hours per week with the opportunity of additional hours
- Compensation is dependent on experience, starting at \$25 per hour
- Employment is through Signature Staff Resources, LLC and managed by WRD Environmental
- Two (2) weeks of paid training and six (6) weeks of youth programming
